

OBERLIN REC CENTER POLICIES

- 1. Children under the age of 14 cannot be issued an Individual Membership.**
 - a. If a child under age 14 is part of a Family Membership, they must be accompanied at all times by their parent/guardian.**
 - i. When the child turns 14, they may be issued upon request their own membership card and are permitted to use the facilities unaccompanied.**
 - b. Children age 14 and older may purchase an Individual Membership and will be issued a member ID card.**
- 2. Rec Center Members must bring their member ID card with them in order to access the facilities.**
 - a. Members are to enter the building through the main entrance front doors only and swipe their ID card on at the turnstiles.**
- 3. Members acknowledge that facilities may close temporarily to patron use due to (but not limited to):**
 - a. Construction and maintenance projects**
 - b. Hosting sporting practices, events, and competitions and college-sponsored events (e.g. swim meets, tennis practices, indoor track meets, basketball games, concerts, banquets etc.)**
- 4. Rec Members are responsible for their belongings. Oberlin College is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- 5. Rec Members are not allowed to let non-Members into the building through back doors or by other means let them gain access to the building. The only patrons allowed to access the facilities are Rec Members and College Students, Faculty, and Staff.**
- 6. Rec Members are to use all equipment and facilities in accordance with posted safety protocols and so as to not endanger themselves or others.**
- 7. The Rec Center is a safe space for all people, their experiences, and their identities, inclusive of but not limited to, their color, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, culture, language, physical abilities, mental abilities, class, and athletic identities. Rec members found to violate this safe space through their language and/or actions will be asked to leave the facilities and may have their membership revoked.**
